CHANDELIER TAKES ALL BLACK ON GR.1 RIDE

Sharp-shooting All Blacks star **Dan Carter** has much to look forward to this weekend.



Just hours before he takes the field for the Crusaders vs Bulls match at AMI Stadium in Christchurch tomorrow, he will be tuned in to see his **O'Reilly** filly **Chandelier** race in one of the country's most prestigious races.

The Crusaders first five-eighth shares in the ownership of the Waikato Stud-bred and raced **Chandelier** (pictured above), the third favourite for tomorrow's **Gr I \$300,000 Wellfield New Zealand Oaks (2400m)** at Trentham.

"I'm pretty excited about the race on Saturday. To be honest I don't know a lot about racing but Mark [Chittick] and the guys at Waikato Stud have got me involved and it's given me a little bit of an insight. From what I've seen, it's an exciting industry - a lot of fun," Carter told Waikato Time's Aidan Rodley yesterday.

Carter became a part-owner of the filly after winning a Claybird shooting competition at Waikato Stud's Game Gully in September, 2009.

The All Blacks visited Waikato Stud in the lead up to the South African test in Hamilton, taking in a tour of the Matamata farm and inspecting the stallions before enjoying some downtime at Game Gully, a shooting range on the farm.

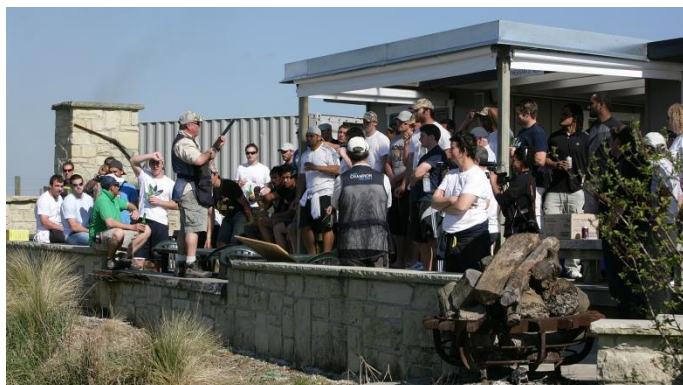
To add a competitive edge to the shoot, Mark Chittick offered a 10 per cent share in a filly to the best shooter.

Carter made his way through to the last four along with captain **Richie McCaw**, **Jimmy Cowan** and **Rodney So'oialo** before emerging triumphant.

"In the final he had to shoot five targets and he got the lot. He was pretty impressive," Chittick recalled yesterday.

"I had a mate helping us out and as he handed Dan the gun he said 'You're under pressure now' and he said back 'I love pressure'."

Hopefully **Chandelier** feels the same way tomorrow as she shoots for her own Gr.1 glory. She faces plenty of stiff opposition including race favourite and fellow **O'Reilly** galloper **High Fashion**, who denied her first place honours at their last encounter in the **Gr.3 Bruce Perry Lowland Stakes (2100m)**.



Trained by Peter and Dawn Williams, **Chandelier** is a winner at 1600m and enters with top three finishes in all of her last three outings.

"It's been a fun ride so far and Mark has kept me up to date with how she's going. He's pretty pumped up about it and he's got me pumped too."

PRESIDENT LINCOLN AIMING FOR DERBY GLORY



O'Reilly's son President Lincoln sets sail in the prestigious **HK-1 BMW Hong Kong Derby** at Sha Tin this Sunday.

President Lincoln won the **Gr.2 Wellington Guineas** in New Zealand before Hong Kong export. Since his arrival to trainer Danny Shum's yard, he has registered one win and three placings for owners Mr & Mrs Cheung Yat Yuen.

Importantly one of these placings came at his last start when second in the **HK-1 Hong Kong Classic Cup (1800m)**.

The Derby was won in 2011 by **Pins'** superstar **Ambitious Dragon**, who will also feature on the night when he takes flight in the **HK-1 The Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup (1400m)**.
